- How often and when can you travel from Saxilby High Street to Bransby Horses? Three times a day (10:30, 11:30 and 12:30) you can travel from Saxilby High Street to Bransby Horses.
- Where do you see timetables and why are they useful? Timetables can be found at bus stops, stations and online. They help us get the correct bus without missing it. They can also help us organise the day.
- What information is displayed in a row when you read across the timetable? Rows show at what times busses are scheduled to stop at a certain stop/station.
- What information is displayed in a column when you read down the timetable? Columns help us identify at what times a certain bus stops at different stops/stations.
