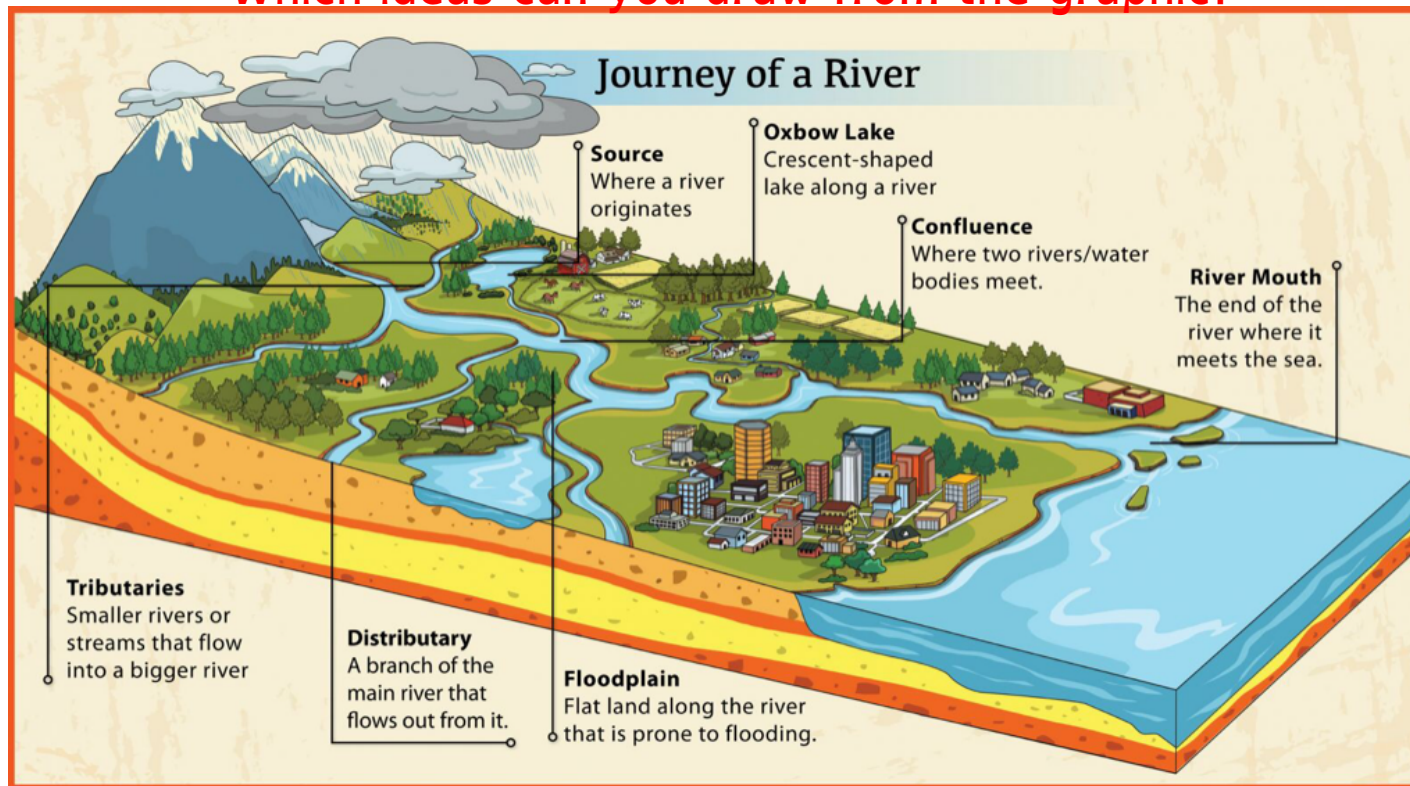


River - Threat or Blessing?

Group of people	Use	positive effect	negative effect
farmer	watering/irrigation, transport,	plants grow better, more profit,	disturb nature, kill animals, dry out areas
fishermen	food, work, hobby, ...	fed, look after family	disturb nature and animal population ...
factory owner and worker	transport, cooling, see use	disturb nature, pollution, ...
power company	create (green) energy	power house, factories ...	disturb nature, change course of river, ...
tourists	transport, exercise, Art, leisure	exercise, positive emotions, Art/photo ...	disturb wildlife (breeding season),
(water) sportsmen	exercise competition	exercise, positive emotions, winning ...	waste/rubbish, threatens wildlife, waste/rubbish.
Environmenta- list, Scientist ...	study and learn, habitats, preserve for the future, ...	preserve, learn, save ...	protection restricts others,

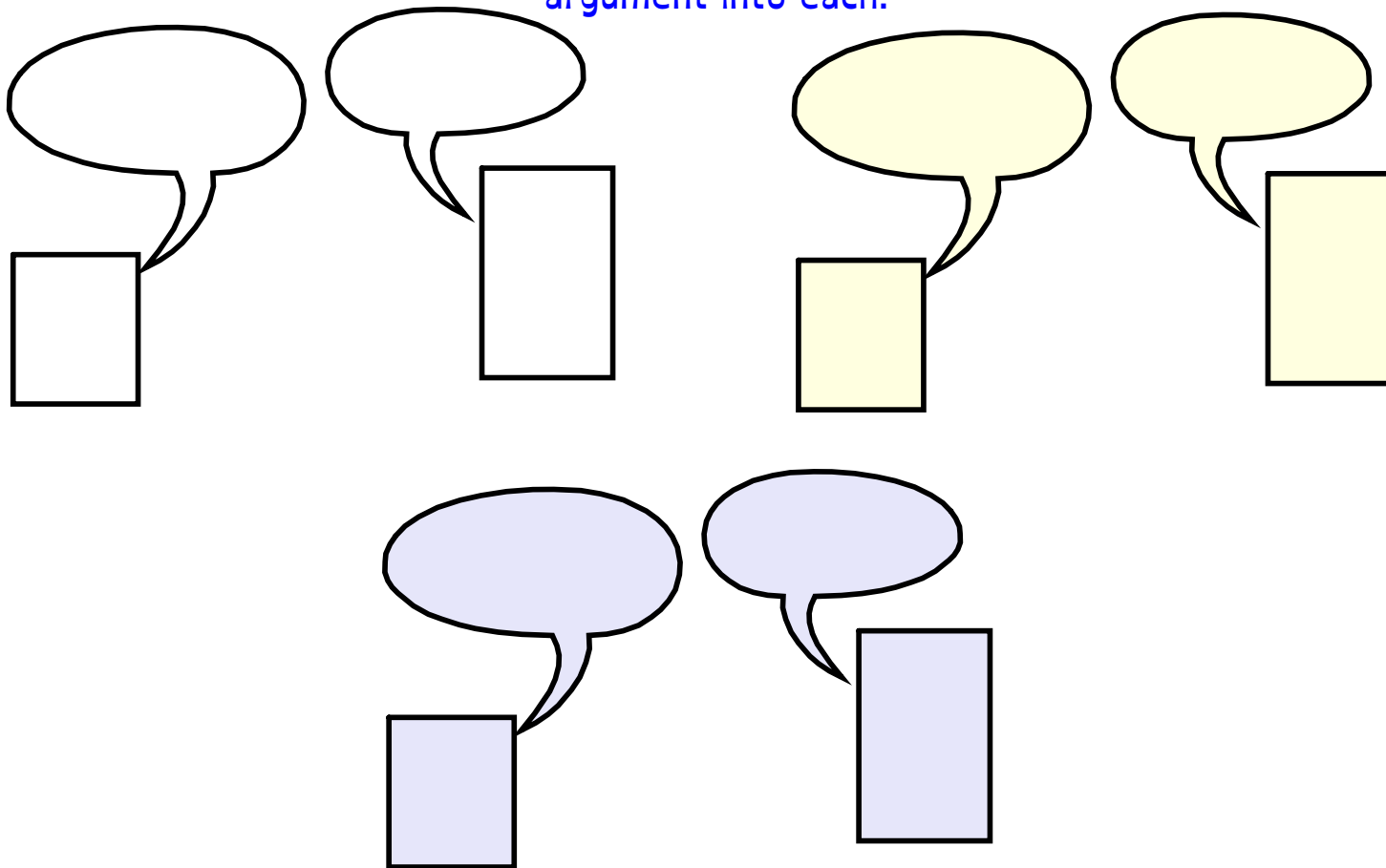
