We would like to thank all our parents for co-operating with us during the staggered entry and exit times. We understand that these new measures can be inconvenient at times, however **safety** must be our priority. Please remember to stick to the following guidelines:

Safety Notice:



Our aim is to keep as many of our pupils and staff in school for as long as possible.

In order to do this, we must remind parents that children displaying any of the following symptoms **must not** be brought into school:

- A high temperature (**above 37.8 degrees**)
- A new, **continuous** cough
- A loss of, or change to, the child's **sense of taste and smell.**

If your child shows any of the above symptoms please **DO NOT BRING THEM TO SCHOOL**. You must keep them at home for at least **10 days**. You must also keep any **brothers or sisters** at home for **10 days**. Please follow the instructions in the flowchart available on our website [here](#).
