SHOULD I KEEP MY CHILD OFF SCHOOL?



YES, Keep your child off school until...

- **Chicken Pox** (until all blisters have crusted over).
- **Vomiting and Diarrhoea** (until 48 hours from the last episode).
- **Flu-like temperature** (until they no longer have a high temperature).
- **Impetigo** (until their sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after they started antibiotics).
- **Measles** (4 days after the rash first appeared).
- **Mumps** (5 days after the swelling started).
- **Scabies** (until they've had their first treatment).
- **Scarlet Fever** (24 hours after they started taking antibiotics).
- **Whooping Cough** (48 hours after they started taking antibiotics).

NO, but tell your child's class teacher if they have:

- Cough
- Sore throat (keep off school if symptom accompanied by a high temperature)
- Earache
- Head lice
- Hand, foot and mouth
- Threadworms
- Glandular Fever
- Slapped Cheek
- Tonsillitis
- Conjunctivitis
