Dear Parents & Carers,

School Day Timings: January 2023 onwards

The Department for Education have advised that by September 2023 at the latest, all state-funded, mainstream schools will be expected to provide a compulsory school week of at least **32** ½ **hours**.

To prepare all children and their families for this mandatory change, Howard Primary School has made the following changes to the school day effective January 2023:

The school day begins at 8.50am for all children

The school day ends at 3.15pm for Reception children and 3.20pm for children in Years 1 - 6

(as communicated in the December 2022 Howard Headlines)

Drop Off (Morning) and Collection (Afternoon)

The gates on Barham Road and Lower Dering Place will be opened at 8.30am; please use these gates to enter the school site. Please note that the gate on Nottingham Road is used as access for children attending Sherwood Pre School; we understand that some of these children have siblings who attend Howard Primary School and the gates along the path will be open up until 8.50am.

The perimeter gates on Barham Road, Lower Dering Place as well as the green gates by the Main Entrance and Reception outdoor learning area (along the path) will be locked at 8.50am sharp.

If your child arrives at school after 8.50am, please bring them to the Office so they can be registered.
