Dear Parents/Carers.

Before and After School Activities (ASAs) - Spring 1

Please find below details of all activities available to children as part of our Extended Schools Programme next half term (January – February half term).

Please note the key information:

- All activities will start from 9th January unless otherwise stated. •
- The collection for all ASAs is 4:30pm, except for football which is 4:20pm
- The collection point is the school office, unless otherwise stated. Please make arrangements for your child's prompt collection as Howard Primary School are unable to provide free childcare.
- All ASA session dates will be the calendar • on on our website https://www.howard.croydon.sch.uk/parent-info/school-calendar/
- If you would like your child to attend any ASA please fill in the online form here: ASA Spring 1 Sign up form. Please fill out a form for each child you have at the school.
- The deadline for returning your responses is **12noon on Thursday 30th November**. ASAs are always popular so please return the form on time to avoid disappointment.
- Once all names have been received, children will be selected at random to take part. If your child is one of those randomly selected, you will receive a text advising you of this by no later than 5.00pm on Friday 1st December 2023. Please note: In the interests of fairness, priority will be given to children who have not had a chance to participate in an ASA this academic year. If there are places remaining after the initial selection, then children who have previously attended will be considered (again via random selection).

Once your child's space has been confirmed on 1st December:

- The deadline date for payments is **12noon on Tuesday 19th December**. We recommend that • payment is made via debit or credit card as payments made via bank transfer take up to 10 working days to clear. If cleared payment is not made by this deadline, we will assume that you no longer want the place, and it will be offered to a child on the waiting list.
- have difficulty accessing vour ParentPav account. lf vou please email office@howard.croydon.sch.uk before the deadline date.
- We are unfortunately unable to extend the payment deadline and are unable to accept childcare vouchers as payment.





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 If payment is not received by the deadline, the place will be offered to the next child on the waiting list.

If there is any reason you are unable to fully meet the cost of any activity on our Extended Schools Programme, but would still like your child to attend, please speak to a member of the Leadership team. Each case will be treated confidentially and on an individual basis.

Football ASA at Howard Primary School

Spring 1 term sees the return of a girls' football ASA at Howard. **Coach Cole** will be running two football sessions, one for boys and one for girls (selected year groups apply). Your child will need to wear their PE kit to school on session days and bring their water bottle. Please make firm arrangements for your child to be collected at 4:20pm.

Year 5 & 6 Netball

Netball club for Year 5 and 6 continues with **Miss Handley**. This is an increasingly popular club on Friday mornings at 8am. Your child will need to wear their PE kit to school on Netball session days and bring their water bottle.

Ballet and Musical Theatre

These clubs are continuing from last term with Miss Thompson from **The Betty Wivell Academy**. Your child will need to wear their PE kit to school on ballet/musical theatre session days and bring their water bottle.

Multi Sports

These sessions will be led by a coach from **Totstars**; the sessions will cover a number of different skills practices such as, dribbling, shooting, passing across many sports, as well as improve the fundamentals of movement.

The children need to wear their P.E kit to school and can bring a healthy snack if they wish. Parents are asked to pick up children promptly after each session as there is no-one available to provide childcare once this after school activity session has ended.
